## Artist Statement

"My work contemplates, questions, reflects, and communicates on psychological, metaphysical, philosophical and social levels about inner peace, self-realization, identity, ethnicity, human rights and evolution. The work often attempts to demystify reality. This is the core. Inspiration is given to me in vision: I sit in silence within my inner cave and let the energy flow and create what I see. The work itself is a journey into the realm of the unknown, and yet a rediscovery of the known."



## Biography

Vivianne Nantel paintings have been exhibited in museums and galleries throughout the United States and also abroad, including the Johnson-Humrickhouse Museum in Roscoe Village, Ohio; the Yosemite Museum in Yosemite, California; the Williamsburg Art and Historical Society of New York City; the Blue Dolphin Gallery in Pensacola, Florida; Woman Made Gallery in Chicago; Powell Street Gallery in San Francisco; and Castle Kruenburg, Austria. In addition, Nantel has been invited to exhibit five of her works in a special show at the Peace Museum in Chicago this May thru August 2003. Nantel's work is in private and corporate collections, including those of Alaska Airlines in Seattle; Gordon and Reese Law Firm and the Rodrick Management Group in San Francisco; My Travels Importing in Vancouver, Washington; Events West and Hamilton PR Ink in Mill Valley, California; Hamsa Yoga Sangh, India; and Mayor Hans Ledolter, Austria. She received a B.F.A. from San Francisco State University, graduating Magna Cum Laude. Articles about Nantel's work have been published in newspapers and periodicals, including the San Francisco Chronicle, The Marin Independent Journal, the Pensacola News Journal, and Alaska's World.
